Then you will be encouraged to go in and see the show prior to opening to the public and place your vote for the Members Choice Award. This will be counted after preview and placed for you to see on Friday.

President Sheri Smith called the meeting to order at 7:05 pm.

NEW BUSINESS

- Changes to the minutes and Treasurer's report were called. Since none were presented both minutes and Treasurer's report were accepted as written in the Common Threads Newsletter of July 2011.
- Sheri recommended that the Treasurer's Report be deleted from all further newsletters. Open discussion was held. Many members reported reading them and this suggestion for minimizing the newsletter was set aside.
- Reading of "Thank you" note from Heritage Farm Museum.
- Notation made that there were many sign-up sheets for volunteering: International Festival, raffle quilt showing, and Quilt Plano 2011 show.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

- Kemberly Wilshire, Show Chair, reported on Quilt Plano 2011. We still have show pins for \$6.00; \$5.00 for salad or sandwich ticket for Friday and Saturday; Kids will get programs; if members work 4 hours on the show they will receive a charm spool to put on Guild pin. - Tina Connolly reported for Cynthia Weisz on mini quilts for the Show. She showed those that had been handed in this evening.
- Helen Wilems, VP Membership, reported that we have 190 entrant quilts for the show. She also reported that we had 72 members present at this meeting with 2 guests (Jane Bayarena and Jean Pingenot) and 5 new members: Sue Brown, Sapana Chhaya, Lynne Haley, Jill Isakson, and Gayle Thurston. Nine door prizes were awarded that were donated by Fabric Fanatics, Jenny Bug's, Quilter's Connection, Quilt Country, Suzy's Quilt Shop, The Old Craft Store, The Quilt Asylum and The Quilter's Workshop. Don't forget to renew your membership by August 1st to be listed in the Guild Directory.
- Terri Mendelow, VP Community Service, thanked those that brought in quilts and suggested that there are still many kits to be made, quilted and bound, all of which may be found on the Community Service table. She reported on the primary Agencies approved by the Board that the Guild will be donating to for the 2011-12 year.
- Janet Plotkin reminded everyone that the next Guild retreat will be in February and there is plenty of space for everyone.

At 7:30 we had a presentation from Germaine Reconnu exhibiting her quilts. At 7:55 was Show and Tell. The meeting was adjourned at 8:05 pm.

The Second Tuesday Sit & Sew group has been very busy. In June, we worked on the adorable "Spot the Dog" quilt tops, provided for us by Sherry Worley and Kaye Dunn. Spot is an annual favorite and you hear many "ooohs" and "aaahhs" when Spot shows up. We also pick our favorites we wish we could take home, as well as the beautiful crocheted afghans June Austin brings in. We are so glad to be able to donate these quilts and afghans to the agencies we support in the community.

In July, the group worked on wonderful, scrappy strip blocks that will go into some really great looking quilts. Karen Christoffer and Carrie Oransky work hard to come up with designs and cut our kits for us. We meet from 10am-4pm, and you can come at the time that best fits your schedule.

Kits for quilt tops and cuddle quilts are available for membership at the Community Service table at each guild meeting. If you would prefer to quilt, we have tops with batting and backing. If you like to do binding, we have quilts ready for this final step, along with the label that tells our recipients where their quilt came from. I have to say, I've been so pleased to see the quilts are coming in with these labels attached! Thank you!

At the Board Meeting on July 11, a vote was taken on the agencies that will receive donations from QGP for the year. They are:

- Children's Medical Center at Legacy: pillowcases and cuddle quilts.
- Collin County Children's Advocacy Center: children's quilts and afghans.
- Parkland Hospital: the stocking project.

There are several agencies which also receive donations from the guild on an occasional basis.
