Board Meeting Minutes, January 7, 2013—Julie Schaefer

M.J. Fielek, Guild President, called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m. at Fabric Fanatics. The next Board meeting will be February 11, 2013 beginning at 1:00 p.m. in the classroom of Fabric Fanatics.

Issues discussed:

- 1) Dolores Williams - Membership** - New member sheets for the directory will be available at the general meeting on the 10th.
- 2) Kemberly Wilshire - Quilt Plano 2013** – 5000 bookmarks will be ordered. Ordering for Show shirts will be at the January general meeting; members must fill out order form and attach \$15.00 in cash or a check. Order forms can be found on the guild website; there will also be blank forms available at the meeting. Guild shirts will be ordered when we have decided on color and design. Price for Guild shirts will be available in about 2 weeks. We are ordering 100 black Lanyards with the Guild Logo this weekend. The price will be \$4.00 per lanyard. We have the judges' contracts for the show. Lisa Erlandson, one of the judges will be writing a letter for the newsletter about what the judges will be expecting when they judge. Donna Petrick moved that, "the Guild accepts the contracts of the 2 specified judges for the Quilt Plano 2013 Show." It was seconded by Margaret Schafer. The motion was carried.
- 3) Jo Ann Hudgins – Guild Activities** – A Debbie Mumm Block of the Month (Natural Wonder) will be started in January. A quilt challenge will be starting soon.
- 4) Margaret Schafer – Education** – There will be an education meeting on Thursday, January 24th at 1:00 p.m. This meeting will be held at First Baptist Church of Plano on the East side at the corner of Ave. M and 15th St.
- 5) Shirley Worley – Texas Association of Quilt Guilds (TAQG)** - TAQG meeting will be the first Saturday in February in Lewisville. Rally Day in July is going to have Sue Reich as speaker.
- 6) Julie Schaefer – Special Committee Volunteer Service Hours.** – All hours from 2012 are due to Julie by Thursday, at the January general meeting.

Sally Ashbacher – Every Quilt Has a Story

Sally Ashbacher has spent a lifetime doing needlework, mostly embroidery, which she perfected at her mother's knee. She progressed from embroidery to clothing

sewing, to crewel needlework, to quilting. The Grandmother's Flower Garden quilt Sally Ashbacher rested under when she was sick with rheumatic fever at age six was lost for many years when her grandmother's household was broken up. Some years later this much-loved quilt was found and mailed to her by her stepmother as a birthday gift--"It was the best birthday present I could have gotten," she notes.

Sally's award winning quilts have been seen in many publications; including Lone Stars: A Legacy of Texas Quilts, Vol. II, 1936-1986 (Austin: University of Texas Press, 1990), p. 154-155; her work has also appeared in Quilt, Quilter's Newsletter Magazine, Stitch & Sew Quilts.

Sally is a member of the Quilter's Guild of Dallas. She teaches locally at the Blue Ribbon Quilt Shop in Wiley, TX. Some of you may have joined Sally on one of her bus tours.

Thank you all so much for all you do for Community Service!

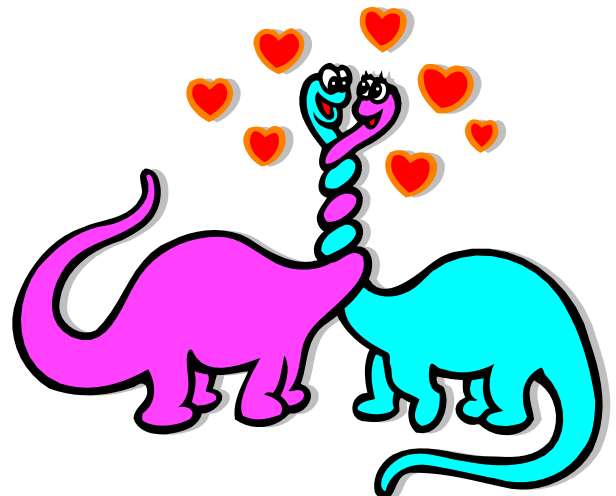

Guild President, M.J. Fielek called the meeting of the Quilters Guild of Plano, Inc. to order at 7:00 p.m. All members and guests were welcomed and asked to please turn off their cell phones. She welcomed the Bear Creek Quilt Guild members showing their raffle quilt, which had a mariner's compass in the center. The next "Have a Cup" will be on the 2nd Friday after the general meeting, which is January 18th at 10:00 a.m., at La Madeleine's on 15th and Highway 75. The next Board Meeting will be on February 11th at 1:00 in the classroom of Fabric Fanatics. The next general meeting will be on February 14th at 7:00 p.m. If you are interested in being a Board Member for the 2013-14 year please contact the present member of that office. Offices such as Treasurer, Secretary, Programs and Community Service will be opening.

MJ called for changes in the December Minutes or the Treasury Report as published in the newsletter. There were none forthcoming therefore both the Minutes and Treasurer's Report were accepted as published. Regarding the boot blocks for the Maverick Quilt Exhibit in Ft. Worth each block is to be 9 1/2" X 12 1/2" unfinished. The Exhibit will be from January 18 through March 31st. Admission to the exhibit is \$25.00. With a boot block in hand along with the form to accompany it (which can be accessed on the web,) the cost will be only \$12.50.

Committee Reports:

Community Service: Terri Mendelow reported that in December 330 stockings were delivered to Soldier's Angels and 44 cuddles went to Children's Medical Center at Legacy. She asked that if anyone has left over fabric from Christmas, please bring it to be used by LaDawn Dalley for next year's Stocking Project. Flannel also is needed to be made into receiving blankets for Parkland Hospital. The Guild is collecting Hobbs batting labels. We use them when we get batting for Community Service quilts. The next Sit and Sew is February 12th from 10:00 to 3:00. You may come and go as needed. It will be held at the Plano Sewing Center which is on the corner of Custer and Spring Creek. Members need to report the service hours they have spent in doing work for the Guild.

Send them to Julie Schaefer at juliescha@sbcglobal.net. You may be eligible for a Guild charm or a Presidential Volunteer Service Award.

Education: Margaret Schafer reminded members about the Education Planning Meeting, that will be held on January 24th at the First Baptist Church of Plano at 1:00 p.m.

Guild Activities: Jo Ann Hudgins showed the first block of the new Block of the Month Program. She had copies of the directions for making the block but members may also go on the website of Debbie Mumm for future blocks in case you want to work ahead. If you are doing this block please bring it to the next Guild Meeting. There will be prizes off and on for doing the blocks. This is a 12 month program and we will judge for favorite quilt in January 2014.

Retreat: Janet Plotkin reported that there is still space for anyone wanting to go on the Guild's Retreat next month.

Quilt Plano 2013: Kemberly Wilshire encouraged members to buy the 2013 Show Shirt tonight. The shirts will be delivered next month at the general meeting. There will be a Challenge to see who can bling their shirt up the best. Raffle tickets won't be available until May. There are still positions on the Show Committee. These are: publication of programs, Quilt Angels, & Raffle Quilt.

Membership: Dolores Williams and Kaye Dunn reported there were 57 members present at the meeting with 2 new members (Lucy Hilton and Susan Gipp), 2 returning members (Lynn Haley and Donna Benedetto) and 1 visitor. Everyone should have their directory at this point. Tonight is the last time Dolores will be bringing directories to the meetings.

TAQG and Door Prizes: Sherry Worley asked members to bring to the next general meeting any paper bags without advertising on them to be used at TAQG Rally Day for door prizes. 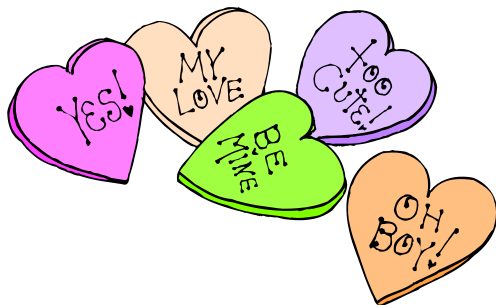
Discussion was held on:

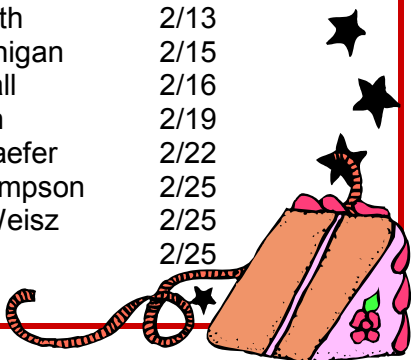

Education News—Margaret Schafer

We had our Education Planning Session for 2013 on Thursday, January 24th. We will have complete details for you in the next newsletter. As you know, education about quilting is a very important part of what we do as a Guild.
