




FINISHED BLOCK SIZE: 16" x 12"


NOTE ABOUT THE TEMPLATES:

A variety of options are provided for each section to allow for a spot of fun. Choose one for each section to create a single link block.

This block can be made as a single link to remind you that you are connected to others. Or you can go all out by sharing blocks with friends around the world, and piece a whole quilt. When coordinating a quilt, the colours of sections B and I need to match up on left and right sides. Group Coordination Instructions are provided to help with this process.




ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS




STEP 1:


- i) Lay the sections out to spell the word "COMBINED".
- ii) Stitch C to 0, 0 to M.
- iii) Stitch B to I.
- iv) Stitch N to E, and E to D.



TIP: Take note of the ★ which indicate
Critical Matching Points. These are there to
alert you that a little extra attention is required
to achieve accurate alignment and awesomeness.



STEP 2:i) Stitch the top and bottom panels to the centre panel.



STEP 3: Ta dah! Your block is complete. Revel in the glory!

A little side bar project trivia:

The word "COMBINED" was chosen for the template labels as, when this project was first conceived it was a surprise for participants. No one knew what the finished block would look like. Members weren't allowed to open their envelopes until the "Big Reveal" meeting on Zoom, when they all opened them and learned about the big picture of the project together. In the event that anyone cheated and preopened their envelopes, I didn't want them to know the order in which they were laid out, so I devised a sneaky plan to have a word instead of alphabetical letters as usual. I searched for a word that had 8 letters that meant "togetherness" without having any duplicate letters. This challenge was trickier than I had thought it might be! I eventually found and settled on COMBINED. So that is the scoop!




1" CHECK




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


1" CHECK


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
